Mr. Mustico,

I have completed a cursory review of the NYSEG Relocation Line No. 69 Watercure Road Substation Erosion and Sediment Control Plan dated May 2019, and received on August 21st, 2019. Based upon my review of the above information, I believe the proposed erosion and sediment control plan is consistent with the Town of Elmira's Stormwater Management and Erosion and Sediment Control Law. This acceptance only pertains work being done for Line No 69 at the Watercure Substation. This acceptance is based on the following

1. Silt and/or sediment shall not be allowed to leave the project site, including tracking onto public streets. Erosion and sediment controls, outlined in the accepted Erosion & Sediment Control Plan, shall be implemented and maintained to ensure this purpose. If silt, sediment, and/or dust are found to be leaving the site, the Owner (or their contractor) shall take immediate actions to correct the situation.
2. One set of the Final Erosion and Sediment Control Plan must be on-site at all times during construction and site stabilization.
